TYPE OF INCIDENT: Robbery, Felony 2nd Degree.

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: May 22, 2009, at approx 4:32am and May 25, 2009, at approx 2:04am

LOCATION: 1231 South Crane, 7-11 Convenience Store.

SUMMARY/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On Friday, May 22, 2009, at approximately 4:32a.m., the Odessa Police Department responded to a robbery at the 7-11 Convenience Store located at 1231 South Crane Ave. The clerk reported that two Hispanic males entered the store and grabbed two thirty pack case of beer, leaving the store without paying. Prior to leaving the store, one of the suspects hit the victim with one of the packs of beer causing injury to the victim's face. Both suspects left the store on foot.

On Sunday, May 25, 2009, at approximately 2:00a.m., the Odessa Police Department responded to a robbery at the 7-11 Convenience Store located at 1231 South Crane. The clerk reported that two Hispanic males entered the store, grabbed two thirty pack case of beer and attempted to leave the store without paying. The clerk attempted to block the door and the suspects assaulted the clerk by hitting him with beer cans.

Suspect description; First robbery, Hispanic male, approximately 18 to 25yoa, 5'10" tall, 220 lbs, wearing Red Polo shirt with white horizontal stripes and has a tear drop tattoo on his face. In the second robbery, suspect wore a white tank top with blue jeans.

Second suspect is a Hispanic male, approximately 18 to 25yoa, 5'8-5"10 tall, 150 lbs, wearing a white tank top with blue jeans. Both suspects are possibly occupying a dark color (red or blue) sports car. In the second robbery suspect wore a White Polo shirt with blue horizontal stripes and blue jeans.
